PARADE INSTRUCTIONS

- DATE OF PARADE:** Saturday, October 1, 2011
Line up begins at 7:00 A.M.
Parade starts at 10:00 A.M.
- PARADE THEME:** “60 years & Still Making History”
- PARADE ROUTE:** The registration desk will be located at the corner of Austin Blvd. and Maley St. You will need to pick up your participant number here. The parade will proceed south from Fremont St. on Haskell Ave., turn left on Stewart then right onto Railroad Ave., then right onto Maley. Then at the stoplight turn left onto Haskell then right onto Wasson St. where the parade will disband.
- SIGNS & VEHICLES:** ALL entries MUST supply their own signs and vehicles. No more than 5 vehicles per entry unless otherwise arranged with Parade Committee and authorized by RAD, Inc.
- TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded at the Keiller Park Stage located on Bisbee Avenue, at approx. 2:00 P.M. Trophies that are not picked up at the park will be taken to the Chamber of Commerce 520 384-2272. NO trophies will be mailed. All trophies will be awarded in their respective categories and the Mayors trophy and cash prize will be awarded to the entry (from any category) that best represents the Parade Theme.

Rex Allen Days Inc. will NOT assume responsibility for personal injury, individual or collective, property and/or equipment.

Please **DO NOT** throw anything from your entry. This is a matter of safety. You are welcome to have someone walking along the side handing out items. Please be mindful of the other parade participants behind you and help keep the parade moving smoothly.

Be aware it will be **HOT** and there is **NO** water available in the staging area. Bring water for yourselves and others in your group.

Deadline is Friday, September 23rd- Late entries will not be accepted. **NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCPETED THE DAY OF PARADE.** Applications **MUST** be filled out and at the registration stand before entries are allowed to stage. Right to refusal of staging is reserved by the Rex Allen Days, Inc.

When filling out the application, please do not use the back of the application for additional comments. Attach an extra paper that can be put in front of the application to make sure the announcer doesn't miss any of your information. Please limit your announcement to 30 seconds to prevent delays and include one paragraph about the parade entry.

In order to keep the parade moving smoothly, **the judges will be scattered along the parade route**, so it is in your best interest to perform your best throughout the entire route. We ask that you please do not stop in front of the announcers stand for more than 30 seconds as no judges will be placed at the announcers stand. **PLEASE INCLUDE LENGTH that you need for your entry this is very important.**
